



Resurrection EASTER SUNDAY

Luke 24:1-6 (NLT) <sup>1</sup> But very early on Sunday morning the women went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. <sup>2</sup> They found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. <sup>3</sup> So they went in, but they didn't find the body of the Lord Jesus.<sup>4</sup> As they stood there puzzled, two men suddenly appeared to them, clothed in dazzling robes. <sup>5</sup> The women were terrified and bowed with their faces to the ground. Then the men asked, "Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive? <sup>6</sup> He isn't here! He is risen from the dead!...

**Luke 24:6-7 (NLT)** <sup>6</sup> He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what he told you back in Galilee, <sup>7</sup> that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that he would rise again on the third day."

**1** Corinthians 15:13-14 (NLT) <sup>13</sup> For if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised either. <sup>14</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your faith is useless.

**Luke 24:13-17 (NLT)** <sup>13</sup> That same day two of Jesus' followers were walking to the village of Emmaus, seven miles from Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> As they walked along they were talking about everything that had happened. <sup>15</sup> As they talked and discussed these things, Jesus himself suddenly came and began walking with them. <sup>16</sup> But God kept them from recognizing him. <sup>17</sup> He asked them, "What are you discussing so intently as you walk along?" They stopped short, sadness written across their faces.

**Luke 24:29-31 (NLT)**<sup>29</sup> but they begged him, "Stay the night with us, since it is getting late." So he went home with them. <sup>30</sup> As they sat down to eat, he took the bread and blessed it. Then he broke it and gave it to them. <sup>31</sup> Suddenly, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. And at that moment he disappeared!

Luke 24:32-33 (NLT) <sup>32</sup> They said to each other, "Didn't our hearts burn within us as he talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?" <sup>33</sup> And within the hour they were on their way back to Jerusalem....

**Luke 24:44-45 (NLT)** <sup>44</sup> Then he said, "When I was with you before, I told you that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled." <sup>45</sup> Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

**2 Corinthians 1:20 (NIV)** <sup>20</sup> For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.

**Job 40:4-5 (NLT)** <sup>4</sup> "I am nothing—how could I ever find the answers? I will cover my mouth with my hand. <sup>5</sup> I have said too much already. I have nothing more to say."

Job 42:2-6 (NLT) <sup>2</sup> "I know that you can do anything, and no one can stop you. <sup>3</sup> You asked, 'Who is this that questions my wisdom with such ignorance?' It is I—and I was talking about things I knew nothing about, things far too wonderful for me. <sup>4</sup> You said, 'Listen and I will speak! I have some questions for you, and you must answer them.' <sup>5</sup> I had only heard about you before, but now I have seen you with my own eyes. <sup>6</sup> I take back everything I said, and I sit in dust and ashes to show my repentance."
